Covid-19 Plan #2

Reopened as of OSRC Friday Feb 19th. 2021 – Revised March 11, 2021

1. If you reside in a RED or GREY area, please stay away!
2. If you are feeling sick or unwell, please stay home!
3. Maintain your social distance at all times.
4. Wash your hands before and after shooting.
5. Sanitize the shooting port before and after you shoot.
6. Sanitize all commonly touched areas.

The Key-Holder that opens the Club is now responsible for the following:

1. Ensure everyone is maintaining his or her social distance.
2. Ensure there are no more than 4 people on the line at one time, using ports 1, 4 and 7 (3 shooters & a RO). 10 people in the waiting area max.
3. Check that all shooters have current membership. If person is a renewing member they will be treated as a guest and will not be allowed to supervise, mentor or act as range officer. A current member (that's present) will need to sponsor them and be held liable for them until membership is fully reinstated. Showing up with a cheque or mailing in a cheque doesn't mean automatic membership reinstatement.

OSRC Policy and Procedure during Covid-19

PLEASE MAINTAIN SOCIAL DISTANCING AT ALL TIMES

1. All range rules will remain in effect.
2. Everyone must sign in as usual, please bring a pen.
3. You will need to bring your own ear and eye protection and hand wipes. (hand sanitizer is provided)
4. Bring a **mask with you and wear it at all times.**
"You have the option to lower your mask below nose while at the firing line". Our President with consultation from the GBHU has confirmed this.

Please ask your fellow shooters about their comfort level before doing so. If there are Masked shooters who do not want to shoot with lowered masked shooters then everyone on the line has to be masked.

5. There will be no guests at this time, unless it is a family member from the same household or potential new member during CLSC or Orientation process. The other exception is a late renewing member that has not been fully reinstated. This renewing member will have submitted their renewal funds but there membership renewal is in process. They can be treated as a guest provided a current member that is present is willing to be held liable and must be willing to observe and watch over them while participating at the firing line.

6. Only ports 1, 4 and 7 will be used to allow for social distancing.

7. Remember, Port 1 is for rim-fire only as usual.

8. When entering the firing line the person at port one goes in first , then 4 and 7, when leaving the line the person at port 7 leaves first then 4 and 1 again, to maintain social distancing.

9. No more than 3 people on the firing line at one time, plus the RSO

10. Maximum of 10 people in the waiting area at any one time.

11. All key holders who assume responsibility of being an RSO should read carefully and understand what they are responsible for.

If you have any questions or concerns, please contact a board member.

12. RSO's (key holders) who are willing to supervise a scheduled shoot for non-keyholder members, will post a notice on the OSRC groups website announcing the date and time.

13. Members should respond directly to the RSO to book a spot.

14. Members on probation who have completed their CLSC and working on their mandatory observed targets may attend and shoot providing they arrange it with the RSO who will be the third person on the firing line, to avoid disappointment please arrange this ahead of time.

15. It has been recommended (and has been working quite well) that the time slots for shooting be limited to one hour for each line of shooters, to allow others the opportunity to shoot while we are under our current Port restrictions. If no one is waiting, by all means stay longer or return on a third line an hour later....

16. Everyone signing the Sign-In book acknowledges they read the Health Self-Check List, and have answered “NO” to all the questions and are accepting full responsibility for their actions and any risk including contracting Covid-19 while at the OSRC.

17. It is every ones responsibility to observe and follow the government guidelines and the guidelines of the Board of the OSRC.

18. The video recordings will be randomly checked, and any violation of the policy and procedures or government regulations may result in disciplinary action up to and including termination of membership and possibly shut down of the Clubhouse.

19. Everyone is responsible for sanitizing all surfaces before touching them, as well as before leaving.

PLEASE BE PATIENT AND CONSIDERATE OF OTHERS AND MAINTAIN SOCIAL DISTANCING AT ALL TIMES

Procedure to book an appointment to shoot

Key-Holders (RSO) will post on the groups.io messaging system when they will open for the non key-holders to shoot.

Those wishing to shoot will contact the RSO **directly** to book a slot within that time slot. The RSO will thus be able to control the number of shooters present.

Please note #3 to #6 below if you are not already signed up.

#3 You do need to register with groups.io account, to join this group. You can subscribe and participate entirely by email.

#4 To subscribe by email simply send a blank email from your desired email account to OSRC-range+subscribe@groups.io . Brad Rodriguez will be notified of your request and will approve it (if he does not recognize your email address, it may take him a few days to confirm you are a current OSRC member)

#5 Once you have subscribed and been approved you can send a message to the group. Simply send an email to OSRC-range@groups.io and it will automatically be distributed to all the other subscribers.

Solo Visits

The BoD recommends the following:

Key-Holders who are concerned about contracting Covid-19 may wish to shoot **alone** with no one else present, (except, in the case of Handgun, when another person **from the same household** would have to be in attendance to comply with "the two-person" rule).

Rather than just going to the Club unannounced, please consider using the groups.io messaging system to schedule a time slot, adding the note that you wish this to be **EXCLUSIVE**.

This makes the process identical to other RSOs booking their hosting time slots, and lets everyone know someone will be at the Club at that time, and wanting to be alone. It will avoid some other "solo" keyholder showing up unannounced and wanting to share with you. It preserves the privilege of being able to go to the Club at an unofficial opening time.

Non-Internet Members

There are a few members who do not have email or Internet access. If you know someone in that situation, please offer to be an "Internet Buddy", to keep them updated on what is happening.
